## Maryland Port Administration/MdTA Police EXTENSION OF VEHICLE PERMIT EXPIRATION

Due to unforeseen circumstances, expiration of the current vehicle permits that was scheduled to expire on Jun 30, 2009 has been extended to July 31, 2009.

Hours for the issuing of new permits or renewal of permits are Monday through Friday, 7:30AM – 3:00PM.

The requirements for the renewal of permits are the same as last year:

- 1) Driver's License
- 2) Port ID Card
- 3) Vehicle registration card
- 4) Proof of current vehicle insurance
- 5) A notarized letter from the vehicle's owner stating the driver has their permission to use this vehicle as their primary means of transportation to work if the person requesting the registration does not own the vehicle.

There may be days when vehicle permits will not be issued due to inclement weather. You may call 410-633-1126 prior to reporting for vehicle renewal registrations to confirm that renewals are being issued.
